## 16 MILLION

In the UK, **11% of children, 23% of working-age adults and 45% of pension-age adults** are disabled.




In the UK, **of all those in poverty, nearly half are disabled** or live with someone who is.

In 2022, **disability hate crime rose** in England and Wales by **43%**.



Disabled people, on average, face **extra costs of £975 a month.**




**54%** of individuals with significant disabilities in the UK, are without a safe or secure home.


wheelchair users aren't living in accessible or suitable conditions in England.

Men with physical impairments experience a pay gap of up to 28%. Men with epilepsy and/or mental illness experience a pay gap of around 40%, and men with learning disabilities experience a pay gap of around 60%.
